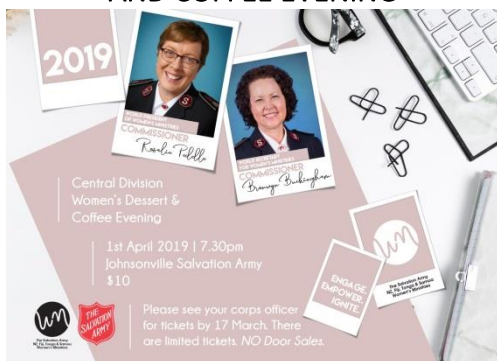
## VISITOR AND NEWCOMERS

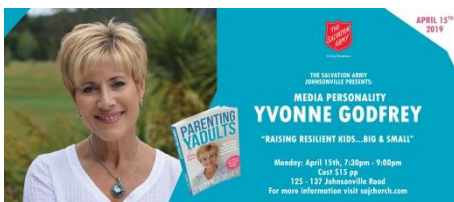

## ENGAGED YOUTH

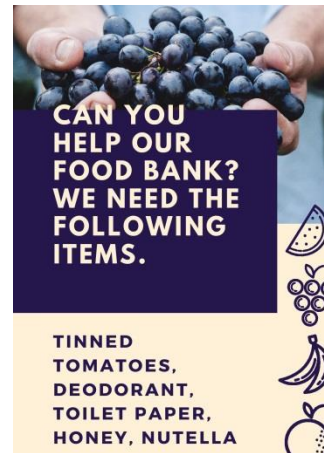
All youth between 13 and 25 years old are warmly invited to attend the weekly meeting that takes place on Friday nights between 7 and 9 pm.
