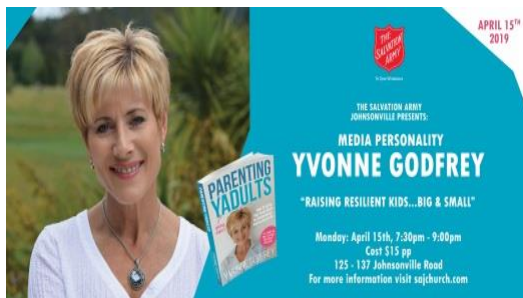
## VISITORS AND NEWCOMERS

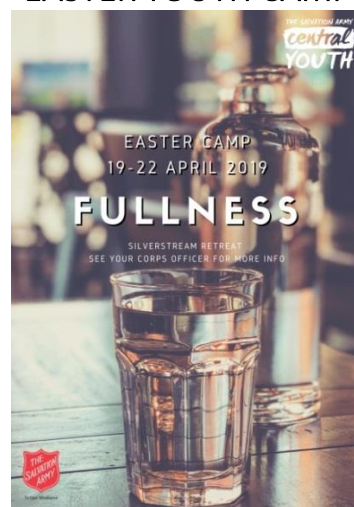
